

CERTIFIED INSTALLATION PROGRAM and PRE-INSTALL CHECKLIST

The Angelo Po authorized service agent will arrange for proper installation of your Angelo Po equipment. Any additional costs beyond those provided as part of the Angelo Po Certified Installation Program are the responsibility of the customer.

Angelo Po Certified Installation Program includes the following:

1. Travel by Angelo Po America Inc. or its designee, within (50) mile radius (one hundred miles round trip) of Angelo Po America Inc. or its designee's office.

2. Assembly, setting, and leveling of the Angelo Po equipment

3. Drain lines, drain vent pipes, and gas connections when Certified Installation performed as part of CombiCare package

4. Start-up demonstration

5. Three (3) year warranty from date of installation or thirty-nine (39) months from the shipping date, whichever occurs first. This is a (1) one year increase over the standard two (2) year warranty.

The **PRE-INSTALLATION CHECKLIST** must be completed before install can begin. This checklist can be found at the end of this document. Contact Angelo Po offices to schedule install. Scheduling of installation can begin upon confirmation that the oven has arrived at the install location. Please allow up to 2 weeks between contacting Angelo Po and completion of certified install by an authorized service agent.

On the scheduled day of installation, the customer must ensure that the Angelo Po equipment is properly positioned within six (6) feet of the installation location and that the work area (within six feet of the equipment) is free and accessible for the Angelo Po authorized service agent to work.

If the installation of the Angelo Po equipment cannot be completed due to local codes and/or government authorities, or if there is a disruption in electrical, gas or water service at the time of installation, or if the Angelo Po authorized service agent is unable to access the utilities due to activities at the facility beyond his/her control, the Angelo Po authorized service agent will, upon request, complete the final installation at a later date to be determined by Angelo Po America Inc. The use of any additional contractor labor, travel and/or parts other than those specified in the Angelo Po Certified Installation Program, is the responsibility of the customer.



The Angelo Po Certified Installation Program does **not** include the following:

1. Overtime travel or labor

2. Installation of the Angelo Po equipment beyond (50) mile radius (one hundred miles round trip) of Angelo Po America Inc. or its designee's office will require an additional travel charge.

- 3. Any work or costs associated with moving the equipment within six (6) feet of the final installed location
- 4. Special licensing or permits
- 5. Unpacking, uncrating, and removal of packing material of Angelo Po equipment
- 6. Removal and scrapping of old equipment

7. Installation of water filtration systems other than the APA RO system. Copper supply lines with shutoff valves, additional tubing, fittings, or any additional water supplies are the end-user's responsibility.

8. Electrical connections such as power cords, cord restraints plugs, and receptacles other than those provided with the equipment.

SPECIAL NOTICE:

Any installation of the above items not included in the Angelo Po Certified Installation is the responsibility of the end-user customer.

Installation of the Angelo Po oven's hose reel or spray hose is to be performed by the Angelo Po Authorized service agency only.

Installation of the Angelo Po oven onto an Angelo Po stand is to be performed by the Angelo Po Authorized service agency only.

Installation of Angelo Po ovens on to any counter or other manufacturers equipment is to be performed by the end-users installer and is the full responsibility of the end-user to ensure the oven placement is secure and safe.

Dealer/Designer/Consultant Responsibilities:

Full completion and submission of the Pre-Installation Checklist to Angelo Po America. Installation cannot begin until this document is received and approved by the Angelo Po technical team.

Dealer Responsibilities include: Inspect, receive, deliver, un-crate, and set oven in place. Check that all accessories are unpackaged and set up for the end user. Verify electric ovens match voltage supply with ovens specific voltage prior to placing order.

Plumbing Requirements:

Provide (3/4" NPT) gas supply line with shut off valve connections verifying proper type, and pressure to the unit. Provide water connections to $\frac{3}{4}$ " cold water lines with required 30-60 psi. Complete oven drainpipe $\frac{1}{4}$ " runs from bottom of oven to floor drain. Provide vent stack from top of drain tee to extend 4" above top of oven. 3 Gas Supply.

All gas supply hoses and connections must be available at time of installation. The end user must install gas shut off ball valve. Service technician will install customer's gas hose to the ball valve and make the final connections to oven and make final gas connections and installation.

Electrical Requirements:

Install proper electrical voltage, phase, wire size, and breaker size for final connections to be made. Oven cannot be connected to G.F.I. receptacle.
